87	Students in Baltimore County Public Schools Served
67%	Both First-Generation <u>and</u> Low-Income
100%	First-Generation <u>or</u> Low-Income
74%	Earned a cumulative GPA of 2.5
100%	Seniors achieved at the proficient level on state assessments in reading/ language arts and math.
100%	Promoted or graduated from secondary school with a regular secondary school diploma.
93%	Graduated from secondary school graduation after completing a rigorous curriculum
